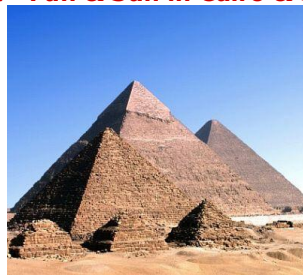

The world's most famous bars....

Perhaps the most famous bar in the world is the Ritz in Paris. Ernest Hemingway and F. Scott Fitzgerald are amongst two notable figures that frequented this famous Parisian hotel bar. The bar is now called the Hemingway Bar.

Harry's bar in Venice, Italy is another bar that was populated by notable figures since it opened in 1931. Again, Hemingway was a regular visitor, alongside Charlie Chaplin, Alfred Hitchcock, Truman Capote and Orson Welles.

At the Eagle and Child pub in Oxford, England, J.R.R. Tolkien came up with the Hobbit after a drink with his author friend C.S. Lewis.

The Long Bar at the Raffles Hotel in Singapore has also become famous thanks to its guest list, Joseph Conrad and Rudyard Kipling amongst two of them.

"The Fighting Cocks" is officially Britain's oldest pub. Cockfighting was banned long ago but the original pit is now one of the bars. Documents prove that a pub stood here in 795. It's also believed that Oliver Cromwell kept his horse in the bar when he stayed here.

"Ye Old Trip to Jerusalem", in Nottingham, has been a castle brew house since 1189. "Trip" originally meant resting place, and the pub was a travel lodge where crusaders drew breath before heading off to slay Saracens.

"The Eagle and Child", in Gloucestershire, claims to be the oldest hotel-pub in England. The inn has a tunnel that leads from the bar to the church, and there is also evidence of a bear pit. Still visible in the rooms are the witches' marks, an ancient frieze and the thousand-year-old timbers.
